Pilot will not light	Gas shut-off valve is turned off	Turn on shut-off valve
	Gas control valve is turned to pilot	Turn gas control valve to ON
	Gas control valve wasn't pushed in	Push in Gas Control Valve
	Igniter was not pushed repeatedley	Push Ingniter repeatedley
	Igniter is bad	Replace Igniter
Main burner does not light	The pilot has gone out	Relight the pilot
	The burner on/off switch is turned off	Turn on burner on/off switch
	The thermostat is disconnected or set too high	Connect thermostat, adjust setting
Fan does not work	Power cord is unplugged	Plug in power cord
	Heater is not up to temperature and sensor has not activated	Allow stove time to heat up for sensor to activate
	Sensor is bad	Replace sensor
Thermostat does not work	Pilot has gone out	Relight pilot
	On/Off switch is turned to Off	Turn switch to ON
	Thermostat is set too high	Adjust thermostat
Flame is dirty and orange, and glass	Logs are not placed properly	Adjust logs

	Burn is obstructed	Remove obstruction
	Air needs to be adjusted	Contact Service Technician
Flames are too short	Hi/Lo flame adjust knob is turned too low	Adjust Hi/Lo knob
